



## *Parent and Family Engagement Policy*

Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Section 1116(b)(1), requires that each Title I, Part A school shall jointly develop with, and distribute to, parents and family members of participating children a written parent and family engagement policy, agreed on by such parents, that shall describe the means for carrying out the requirements of subsections (c) through (f). ### **GENERAL EXPECTATIONS**

Wessendorff Middle School agrees to implement the following:

- Wessendorff Middle School will develop with parents and distribute to parents of participating children a Parental Involvement Policy on which the school and parents **agree**.
- Wessendorff Middle School will notify parents about the Parental Involvement Policy in an understandable and informative format. The Parental Involvement Policy will be distributed to parents in a language the parents can understand.
- Wessendorff Middle School will make the Parental Involvement Policy available to the local community.
- Wessendorff Middle School will periodically update the Parental Involvement Policy to meet parents' and schools' changing needs.
- Wessendorff Middle School agrees to be governed by the following statutory definition of parental involvement and will carry out programs, activities, and procedures per this definition:

*Parental involvement means the participation of parents in regular and meaningful communication involving student academic teaming and other school activities, including ensuring-*

- a. parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning; (BJ parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education at school;*  
*(CJ that parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child;*  
*(DJ the carrying out of other activities, such as those described in section 1118 of the ESEA.*



## *Parent and Family Engagement Policy*

Wessendorff Middle School will implement required school parental involvement policy components as follows:

1. Wessendorff Middle School will involve parents in the joint development of its Parental Involvement Policy in an organized, ongoing, and timely manner, through the annual Title 1 meeting and other meetings as needed.
